### Biopsy Results

#### Background:


Biopsy results are usually not available up to around three to four weeks after the biopsy procedure. For this reason, biopsy results will no longer be a required field at the time of adding the biopsy record. You will be able to add a biopsy record and save it. You could then add the results at a later time by editing the record.

#### Navigation:

PROMIS 4 > Patient Overview > Results > Biopsy

#### Functionality

When you navigate to add a biopsy event, you will notice a note stating *“The Primary Biopsy result can be added on the detailed page after Save”*. The *Primary Biopsy Result* section will be available once the biopsy procedure details have been added.



After you save a biopsy event/record, the user can edit the record and add the biopsy results under the *Biopsy Results* section at the bottom of the form.
