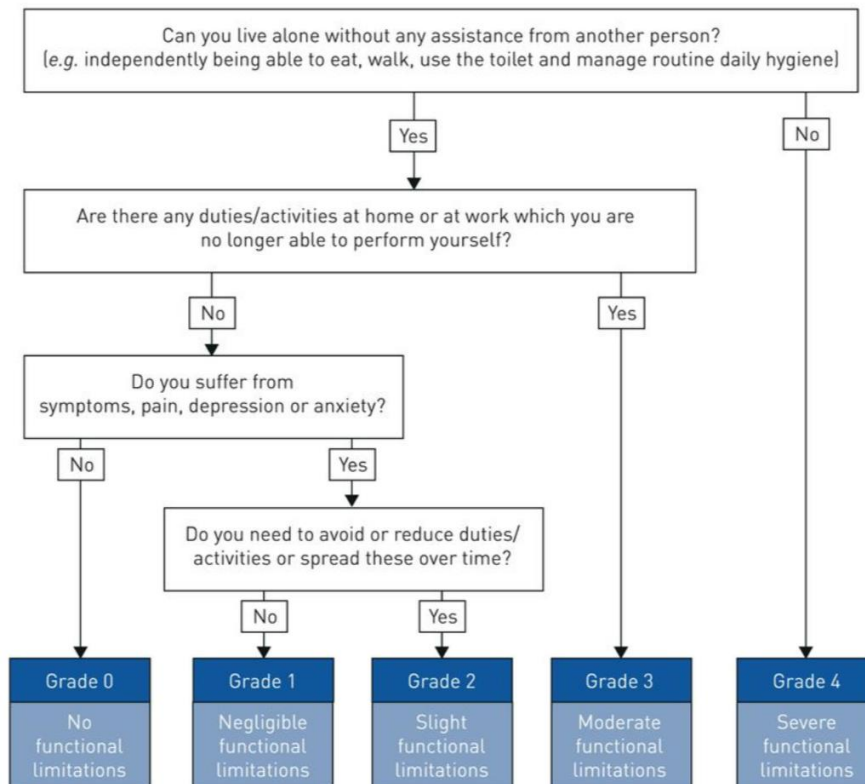
PCR Functional Status Scale

Background:

4.16 release will be introducing a new PCR Functional Status Scale, a simple tool to monitor the course of symptoms and the impact of symptoms on the functional status of PCR patients, i.e. a scale that can measure the consequence of the disease beyond binary outcomes such as mortality.

Five grades have been defined. In short, grade 0 reflects the absence of any functional limitation. From grade 1 upwards, symptoms, pain or anxiety are present to an increasing degree. This has no effect on activities for patients in grade 1, whereas a lower intensity of the activities is required for those in grade 2. Grade 3 accounts for the inability to perform certain activities, forcing patients to structurally modify these. Finally, grade 4 is reserved for those patients with severe functional limitations requiring assistance with activities of daily living.

The grade is calculated using the below chart:

Functionality:

To take a patient survey or PCR questionnaire the Centre may provide the PROMIS team with the questions to be asked. Once the survey is done the user may add the details.

To Add the Survey details to the patient profile:

Complete the general information section:


- **Survey Date:** The date and time of the survey taken.
- **Visit Centre:** The name of the PCR centre where the Survey was taken.

Complete the questionnaire section:

- **Questionnaire:** This section will show 4 questions. The first question is compulsory to answer with the option of Yes or No. For the rest of the questions, there will be an option to choose between the answer Yes, No or Not Answered. The necessity to answer the rest of the questions is based on your answer to the first question. For example, if the user selects "No" to question 1 then the remaining questions can be left blank or unanswered. And if the user selects "Yes" for question 1 option then they must answer 'Yes' or 'No' for question 2.
- When the user clicks 'Save', the system will save the survey.
- User may add more than one survey.

View of the Survey

When the user clicks a specific record, the view page appears providing details of the survey and the ability to Edit or Delete the record. It would provide details with General Information of the questionnaire, the list of questions and under Miscellaneous section details like who created the survey, which dates when it was edited and by whom.

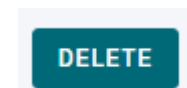


