

## CST Cerner HD Prescriptions Displayed in PROMIS - FAQ

HD Prescriptions recorded in CST Cerner for VPP adult sites are now displayed in PROMIS under Dialysis Prescriptions. Please see below for some “Frequently Asked Questions” related to this change.

### **Can I tell whether a prescription is from Cerner or whether it was directly entered in PROMIS**

HD Prescriptions autoloading from CST Cerner are identified with an Autoloaded label, as highlighted below.

### **Is everything from the Cerner prescription available in PROMIS?**

There are some limitations to what can be populated in PROMIS as a result of differences between the HD prescription built in CST Cerner, and what is required in PROMIS. Values from the Cerner prescription that cannot be mapped to a PROMIS field are stored “as is” in the “Autoloaded Notes” field (see screenshot below).

### **What if I need to change a prescription?**

PROMIS HD Prescriptions cannot be edited, only ended or canceled. If you want to make changes to a prescription that has been autoloading, please end or cancel the prescription in CST Cerner and create a new prescription. When the new prescription is received in PROMIS, the system will end date the previous prescription in PROMIS.

### **I entered an HD prescription in Cerner, but I don't see it in PROMIS. Why not?**

Please note that HD Prescriptions are received from Cerner and processed by PROMIS every morning at 12:30am therefore updates to the HD prescription in CST Cerner will not be available in PROMIS until the following day.
