Background:


The Dialysis Status module is used to track any type of dialysis treatment that a patient undergoes while registered in one of the renal programs. This module will be moved into PROMIS 4 in the 4.18 release.

Functionality:


The Dialysis Status Summary screen shows a list of all dialysis treatments that have been entered for the patient.

Adding a dialysis treatment:

- A patient must be registered in one of the following renal programs in order to have a Dialysis Status record: Provincial Renal Agency, Transient Renal or Other Renal.
- To add a new dialysis treatment record, click on the "Add" button. This will open the following form:



- In the *Add Dialysis Status* form, the *Program* field defaults to the most recent renal program registration.
- If an entry has dates that overlap with another entry, a warning comes up but you are still able to save the record.
- Saving this form will add a new dialysis status record on the *Dialysis Status Summary* page.
- If the *Dialysis Location* selected is *Home*, a warning will pop-up about a missing *Water Source* if this information was not entered in *Demographics*.
