

PROMIS 4.19 Training

Background:

The Interprovincial Organ Sharing Heart (IPOS Heart) is an initiative to have a consistent national approach that defines eligibility and allocation of hearts interprovincially for highly sensitized patients (cPRA \geq 80) and/or a Medical Status of 4 by using the Canadian Transplant Registry (CTR).

After the donor coordinator runs the allocation for BC donors and processes incoming offers for BC recipients in CTR, the list of BC donors and BC recipients who are impacted by this process must be shared with BCT administration team regardless of offer outcome.

Navigation:

PROMIS Classic > Transplant (for accessing Donor Registration, Donor Immunology, Deceased Donor Attachments screens).

PROMIS 4 > Donor Overview > Allocations > Heart Outgoing Offers (for retrieving allocation list for a single donor)

PROMIS 4 > Reports > Centre Reports > Transplant > Donor > Heart Allocation Donor List


PROMIS 4 > Patient Overview > Transplant > Heart HSH Incoming Offers (for retrieving incoming offers for a single recipient)

PROMIS 4 > Patient Overview > Centre Reports > Transplant > Recipient > HSH Offers Recipient List

Changes:

- Two new reports are now available to retrieve allocations and incoming offers in PROMIS for a list of donors and recipients.
 - Heart Allocation Donor List
 - HSH Offers Recipient List
- Two new screens are now available to retrieve allocations and incoming offers in PROMIS for a single donor or recipient.
 - Heart Outgoing Offers
 - Heart HSH Incoming Offers

- It is important to retrieve/pull the latest versions of the *Heart Incoming Offers* and *Allocation Donor lists/Outgoing Offers* to ensure that the system recognizes intended and unintended recipients when the *Transplant Procedure* screen is filled out.
- A user shall be taken to the User Guide for more information on *Heart Allocation Donor List report* and *HSH Offers Recipient List*.
- *Donor Log ID* field in *Transplant Procedure* form is now mandatory.
- When user enters a donor record in the *Transplant Procedure* screen and clicks on the *Save* button, the system will identify if the recipient was not the intended recipient of the offered organ.
- If the recipient is found to be the unintended recipient, the following prompt will be used to inform the user that the donor organ has been transplanted to the unintended recipient and allow the user to enter a reason for doing so.
