Medication Reconciliation

Background:


The Medications Reconciliation module is used to capture details of a reconciliation interview between a patient and their healthcare provider. This is where any discrepancies in the patient's medications are recorded.

Navigation:

PROMIS 4 > Patient Overview > Meds/Other > Medication Reconciliation

Functionality:


- The *Medication Reconciliation* summary page shows all previously captured medication reconciliation records.
- To include any cancelled records, click on the *Include Cancelled Records* button. Cancelled records appear in red text.
- Any records previously added by a user could be edited by the same user only by using the pencil icon under the *Actions* column.
- Any records previously added by a user could be cancelled by the same user only by using the cancel icon under the *Actions* column.
- You could only edit or cancel a medication reconciliation record that you have added yourself. For all other records, only viewing is possible.

- To add a record, click on the *Add* button and fill out the form. Indicate the *Reconciliation Date*, *Reconciliation Type*, *Reconciler Name*, *Intentional Discrepancies*, *Unintentional Discrepancies*, *Unknown Discrepancies* and the *Interview Time*. Click on *Save* to save the record.
