Background:


All Donor modules will be moved into PROMIS 4 in this upcoming release including the Referral module.

Navigation:

PROMIS 4 > Donor Overview > Referrals

Functionality:

When a registration for a living or deceased donor is saved, the registration information is visible in the Donor Referrals screen.

For Living Donor:

The Referrals screen divided into three tabs: Referrals, Medical History & Care Providers, Procedure & Recipient Info (Living Donor).

Referrals:

The Referrals tab includes information that was entered into Donor Registration when the donor was registered.

A current referral must be closed before a new referral could be added. To do this, select the *Closed* option in the *Donor Status* field and click on *Save*. Then add a new referral by clicking on *New* in the top right.

Medical History & Care Providers:

This is where the donor's medical history (diabetes, hypertension, current history, past history, social history) are captured.

Also captured here are the donor's care providers.

Procedure & Recipient Information (Living Donor):

This is where the details of the transplant procedure and recipient are captured.

For Deceased Donor:


The *Referrals* screen divided into three tabs: *Referrals*, *Test Results*, *Medical History & Care Providers*.

Referrals:

The *Referrals* tab includes information that was entered into *Donor Registration* when the donor was registered.

Test Results:

The *Test Results* section will show a section for mother's tests if the donor is breast fed or under the age of 18 months.
